Common Questions we receive:

Q: How do I send MAB my CE certificates?

A: You may email your certificates to us at mab@mrec.state.ms.us or fax your certificates to 601-321-6956. We try our best to upload your CE to your licensing file within 24 hours or less.

Q: I cannot locate my pocket card; how do I request a new one?

A: You no longer have to request a pocket card if yours cannot be located! By logging into your licensing file online you may print a new pocket card instantly. It is generated in a pdf format for your convenience.

WANT TO KNOW WHAT IS HAPPENING:

MAB FINGERPRINTING:

Made effective January 1, 2016, the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board requires that all applicants for a Mississippi real estate appraiser license and all applicants for renewal of any Mississippi real estate appraiser license or certification, shall undergo a fingerprint-based criminal history records check of the Mississippi central criminal database and the Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history database.





DID YOU KNOW:

The Mississippi Appraisal Board is in its second year of providing Appraisers with an online portal giving the ability to renew their license, check continuing education compliance and check their licensing file with MAB. This also allows MAB to electronically email renewal invoices and other important correspondence to you but cannot do so if your email address with us is not current. If you have not logged on to the new MAB licensing portal and verified your information, please do so today.
