

NEW MREC TESTING PROCEDURES

Beginning September 1, 2010 the MREC will no longer offer real estate examinations at our office in Flowood. All testing and examinations will be administered by "PSI Testing Service" and exams will be given at various locations for applicants. Those persons taking the exams will have a choice of taking the exams in Jackson, Memphis, Mobile, New Orleans, Baton Rouge, and various other locations. Exams will be administered daily with little, or no, waiting periods.

All applicants who submit applications on or before August 1, 2010 will be tested (including any re-tests) in the MREC Office during the month of August. All applicants who submit documents to the MREC after August 1, 2010 will be tested by "PSI" at one of their locations.

A fee of \$135.00 for a broker applicant and a fee of \$110.00 for a salesperson applicant will still be charged by the MREC to process the application, verify education, certify the applicant and issue the license for a one (1) year period of time. An additional fee of \$75.00 will be charged by "PSI" to administer, grade and report the results of the exam. The examination fee will be paid directly to "PSI" after the MREC approves the applicant for testing.
