Dear Mississippi Real Estate Broker:

The claims administrator of the BP Gulf Coast Claims Facility (GCCF) has announced a special allocation from the fund for licensed real estate professionals in the Gulf Coast region, including Mississippi. The Mississippi REALTOR® Hurricane Relief Fund has received a portion of these funds, and has contracted with a third party professional claims adjustment firm, National Catastrophe Adjusters, Inc. to ensure the timely, efficient and fair processing of all claims.

The fund is intended to provide **emergency payments** to licensed real estate brokers and agents for verifiable losses incurred as a result of the oil discharges from the April 20, 2010 Deepwater Horizon incident ("the Spill"). In Mississippi, real estate activity in Hancock, Harrison and Jackson counties will have priority eligibility under the prescribed protocol. No waiver of future action against BP is required to receive these emergency payments.
