The Legal Counsel and the Investigative Staff of the Real Estate Commission determined that the information obtained during the investigation of this complaint is sufficient to show that your actions in this matter were contrary to Commission administrative Rule 3.3 (Advertising) in that you were not yet a licensed agent at the time you advertised yourself as one on social media and, further, that you held yourself out to the public as one at a public event in Ocean Springs, MS.

This Official Letter of Reprimand will be placed in your file to become a part of your permanent record. You should take every precaution to familiarize yourself with the Real Estate Brokers License Act of 1954, as Amended, and the Administrative Rules and Regulations of the Real Estate Commission in order to avoid a serious violation which might affect the status of your license.
