The Legal Counsel and the Investigative Staff of the Real Estate Commission determined, and the Commission subsequently decided, that the information obtained during the investigation of this complaint was sufficient to show that your actions in this matter were contrary to the Administrative Rules and/or Miss. statutes as are outlined in the Agreed Informal Resolution filed in the case referenced above. As a Principal Broker, you had an obligation under Rule 3.1 to educate and supervise the advertising activities of the involved salesperson, Faith Stuart.

This Official Letter of Reprimand will be placed in your file to become a part of your permanent record. You should take every precaution to familiarize yourself with the Real Estate Brokers License Act of 1954, as Amended, and the Administrative Rules and Regulations of the Real Estate Commission in order to avoid a serious violation which might affect the status of your license.
