

SWORN CERTIFICATION OF APPLICANT FOR REAL ESTATE BROKER'S LICENSE

Thirty-Six (36) Month Restriction on Employment of Real Estate Salespersons.

Effective July 1, 2020, Miss. Code Ann. §73-35-7 provides that an applicant for a real estate broker's license issued by the Mississippi Real Estate Commission must execute a written statement, <u>under penalty of perjury</u>, certifying that the applicant will not hire any real estate salesperson(s) until they (Broker) have been on active status for a period of thirty-six (36) months following the date of approval of his or her original (active) real estate salesperson's license.

Exceptions:

This signed certification is not required and the salesperson employment restriction shall not apply, if:

1. The applicant has held an active salesperson's license for a <u>cumulative</u> period of thirty-six (36) months <u>prior</u> to making application for the real estate broker's license examination.

<u>OR</u>

2. The applicant has successfully completed a minimum of one hundred fifty (150) <u>classroom</u> hours in real estate courses, which courses are acceptable toward a degree at a college or university as approved by the Southern Association of colleges and Schools.
