## AGREED JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION

Cook understands and agrees that the Court will retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of implementing and enforcing this injunction, and understands that if he violates the terms of this injunction, he may be found to be in contempt of this Court and may be sanctioned or imprisoned. The parties agree that entry of this Agreed Judgment of Permanent injunction neither precludes the investigation of claims or charges, or the pursuit of civil or criminal remedies by other interested parties or any state or federal authorities, nor precludes Defendant

## **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Terry J. Cook be PERMANENTLY

ENJOINED from practice as a real estate appraiser without the license required by Mississippi

Code Ann. §73-34-5.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Terry J. Cook shall produce to counsel for the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board, within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of this Agreed Judgment of Permanent Injunction, a copy of all appraisals completed by Defendant on or after March 20, 2014. The requested copies, if any, shall be mailed to William H. Hussey, Maxey Wann, PLLC, Post Office Box 3977, Jackson, Mississippi 39207-3977.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court shall retain jurisdiction to enforce this

Agreed Judgment of Permanent Injunction and the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing
and Certification Board may engage in post-judgment discovery to monitor Defendant's
compliance with the terms of the judgment.
