



**SWORN CERTIFICATION OF APPLICANT
FOR REAL ESTATE BROKER'S LICENSE**

Thirty-Six (36) Month Restriction on Employment of Real Estate Salespersons

EXCEPTION:

The "salesperson employment restriction" shall not apply, if:

The broker applicant has held an active salesperson's license for a cumulative period of thirty-six (36) months prior to being issued his or her broker's license.

Code Ann. §73-35-7 provides that an applicant for a real estate broker's license issued by the Mississippi Real Estate Commission must execute a written statement, under penalty of perjury, certifying that the broker applicant, upon licensure, will not hire any real estate salesperson(s) until said broker has been on active status for a period of thirty-six (36) months following the date of approval of his or her original real estate license, whether that original license was a salesperson's license or a broker's license.
